What's Happening in Calgary(and area)...

Calgary, May 1, 2014 - According to CREB (referencing metro Calgary stats only)...**Price gains encouraging new listings**. Following a slow start to the year, improved weather and price gains supported new listings growth. New residential listings in April totaled 3,754 units, an eight per cent increase over the previous year. Meanwhile sales activity totaled 2,545 units for the month, a seven per cent increase over April 2013.

Buying or Selling in the Next Few Years?

PRICES CONTINUE TO RISE FOR BOTH NEW BUILD HOMES AND RESALE HOMES IN CALGARY AND AREA. The Calgary region had the highest year-over-year gain in new home prices in February, according to Statistics Canada. The federal agency reported that the New Housing Price Index in the metropolitan region of Calgary rose by 6.9% from a year ago. On an annual basis, prices were up only 1.5% across the country.

Home prices continue to rise is the resale market, too. Recently, the Canadian Real Estate Association said Alberta will lead the country with the highest annual growth rate in prices over the next two years in the resale housing market. It said average MLS sale prices will climb in the province by 3.9% this year to \$396,000 and by another 2.5% in 2015 to \$406,000.

Helpful Spring Maintenance Tips

Gutters and Roofs

Look for damaged shingles. Arrange for a professional inspection every few years. Make sure gutters are secure, without any leaks, and clean out any debris.

Foundation

Check and seal any cracks and imperfections, or call a contractor to do the job. Level any areas in the yard that could cause water to pool after a big rain. Air Conditioning

Have an HVAC contractor service your air conditioning unit to make sure it's running at peak efficiency.

In the Garden It's the season to remove leaves and other winter

debris, turn over the soil and add compost.

Attic and Basement

Check for a musty scent and signs of leaks or seepage. If you have a sump pump, make sure it's still operational.
