

Tips to Prepare For a Showing (Client Perspective)

- 1. Clean front door
- 2. De-clutter
- 3. Make sure windows are open for fresh air & a good scent is left
- 4. Candles
- 5. Air fresheners
- 6. Fresh flowers in vase
- 7. Good, appropriate music
- 8. Cookies left to keep buyers in the house longer
- 9. Clean house
- 10. Fresh flowers on the table
- 11. Clear off kitchen countertops
- 12. Clean windows
- 13. Hire a designer to help arrange furniture & stage
- 14. Fresh coat of paint or touch ups
- 15. Repair obvious issues ex. squeaky door hinges
- 16. Make sure all lights are working & leave lights on, especially outside lights at night
- 17. Enhance views from windows if possible
- 18. Clear walkways
- 19. Shovel snow (front walks, front porch, driveway, back deck)
- 20. Welcome mat at front door
- 21. Have the heat on
- 22. Empty garbage & recycling
- 23. Have fluffy towels in the bathrooms
- 24. Empty mailbox
- 25. Leave RPR out if available
- 26. Community newsletter available on counter / school & park announcements
- 27. Ensure all appliances & garage door opener work
- 28. Put your "buyer" eyes on & see what's missing
- 29. Fix fence if needed
- 30. Remove any carpet stains
- 31. Steam clean carpets especially if the home has been smoked in
- 32. If necessary, remove old carpet & redo hardwood
- 33. No one home, remove tenants/owners/pets
- 34. De-personalize & remove family photos
- 35. Mow the lawn, weed the gardens, manicure flower beds
- 36. Remove evidence of pets ie) litter
- 37. Clean out fridge so no smells
- 38. Clear magnets off of the fridge
- 39. No personal notes lying around, including calendars with dates marked
- 40. Pack up the kids' toys
- 41. Open all window coverings to let in natural light
- 42. Sort & organize storage areas (garage & basement)
- 43. Have home inspection done (evaluate roof, furnace)
