

## What Will The Home Inspector Look For?

- 1. Water damage
- 2. Evidence of moisture in walls, around windows
- 3. Condition of Roof (age)
- 4. Wiring (aluminum)
- 5. Outlets grounded & properly installed
- 6. Condition of basement walls
- 7. Structural defects
- 8. Drains work
- 9. Lights work
- 10. That the appliances all work (stove, dishwasher, fridge, washer, dryer)
- 11. Furnace (age, heat exchanger)
- 12. Carbon monoxide
- 13. Window seals (condensation in windows)
- 14. Insulation in the attic
- 15. Water pressure
- 16. Grading & drainage around the home
- 17. Downspouts in place
- 18. Sealant in tubs
- 19. Grout cracked or sealed
- 20. Moldy grout or caulking
- 21. Garage door
- 22. Evidence of moisture around toilet
- 23. Types of trees in the yard (will they plug drains)
- 24. Find any latent defects
- 25. Exterior structure of the home
- 26. Cracks in basement/foundation
- 27. Door seals & work
- 28. Check the electrical & plumbing systems (electric panel/type of piping & age)
- 29. Hot water tank (estimate age)
- 30. Check for obvious signs of mold or environmental conditions
- 31. Recommend preventative maintenance
- 32. Safety issues ie) railing on stairs or deck
- 33. Rotting of wood ie. decks, fences
- 34. Ensuring water taps outside are off in winter
- 35. Building code issues
- 36. Insect/pest problems
